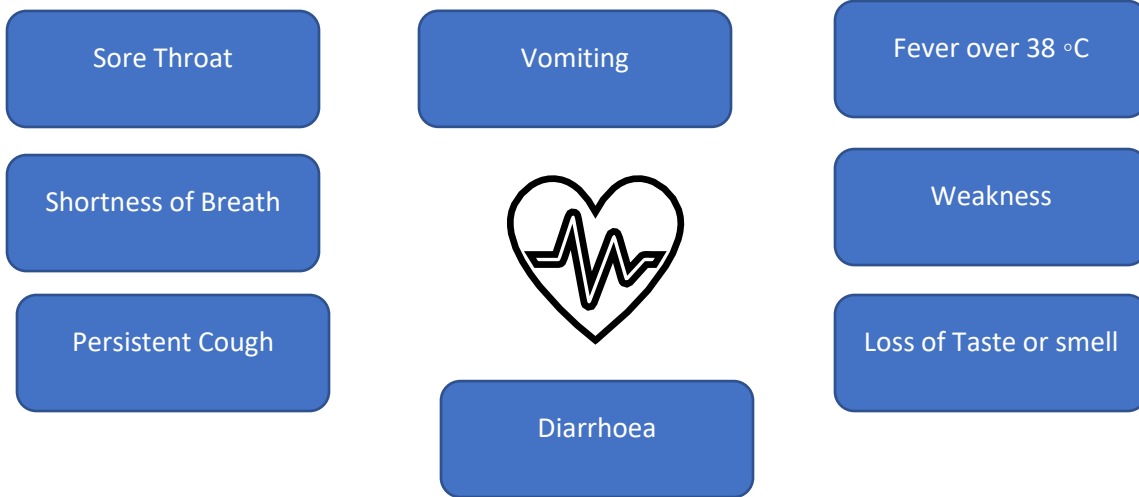




GRANTLEY COLLEGE COVID -19 AWARENESS PROTOCOLS

With the return to school it is inevitable that in the days, weeks and months ahead, as we learn to live with COVID 19, member of our school community might test positive for the virus. Understanding this, we need to be equipped with the knowledge of how to deal with the situations that could arise, without spreading anxiety and panic.

SITUATION 1 – IF YOU OR ANYONE IN YOUR IMMEDIATE FAMILY IS NOT FEELING WELL



If you have more than one of the above symptoms – **Stay at Home.**

If it is flu, it will pass in two days, if not please be tested for Covid-19

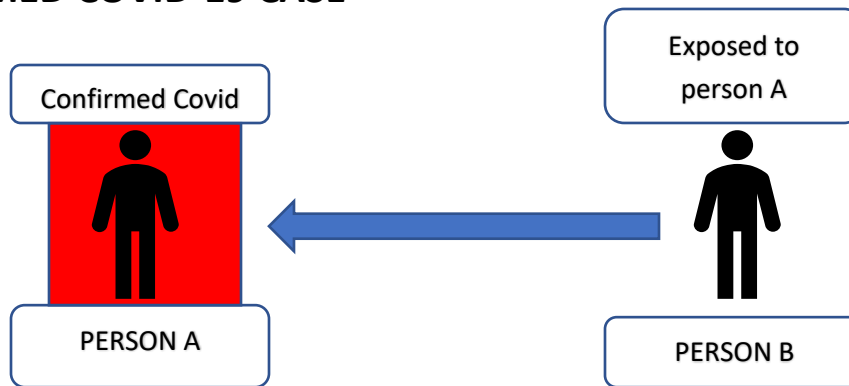


Stay at home until the medical practitioner gives you permission to return to school.



Immediately inform the Principal and Lead Team that they can monitor the situation.

SITUATION 2 – A STAFF MEMBER OR LEARNER BEING EXPOSED TO A CONFIRMED COVID-19 CASE



Staff member or learner have been in contact with a confirmed covid-19 case.
Contact means: face to face within 1.8 m and for more than 15 minutes
Contact means: In direct physical contact with the confirmed case
Contact means: sharing a meal
Contact means: living in the same household



Person B – the Contact person will be in isolation for 14 days from the last day they were in contact with the confirmed Covid-19 case.



Immediately inform the Principal and Lead Team that they can monitor the situation



If the Covid-19 positive person was at school, but the exposure was not from school, they will be isolated immediately, the parents will be contacted and health officials contacted for further instruction, risk assessments and recommendations.

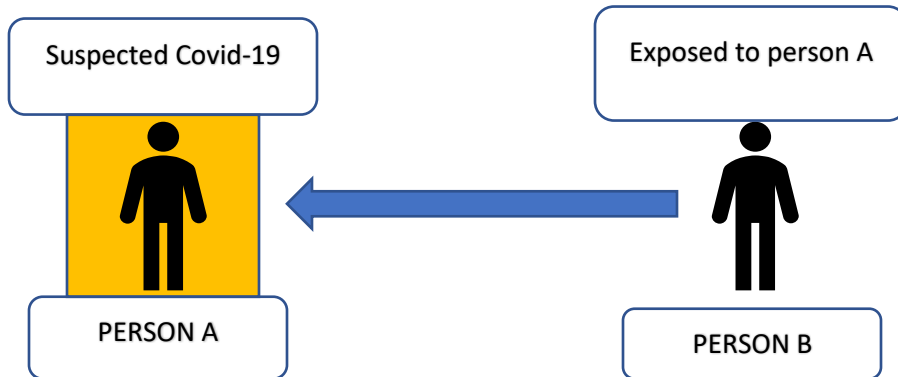
This might result in a grade moving to on line classes for a period of time, but in most cases a school closure will not be required



If the Covid-19 positive person **was** at school, and the exposure is traced to the school, after isolation and removal from the premises, the health officials will be contacted for further instructions, risk assessments and recommendations.

Tracing will take place and the school will be closed for deep cleaning.

SITUATION 3 – IF A STUDENT OF STAFF MEMBER HAS BEEN EXPOSED TO SOMEONE SUSPECTED OF HAVING COVID-19



This may refer to someone who is showing signs of Covid-19, has gone for the test but does not have the results – Person A

Person A, must not come to school, until the results of the test are negative. Person B, having been exposed to person A, must also stay at home until a negative result is confirmed.



If the test for Person A comes back positive, Person B who was waiting at home must be tested immediately



If Person A and Person B found out about the suspected case at school, immediately inform the Principal and Lead Team that they can monitor the situation



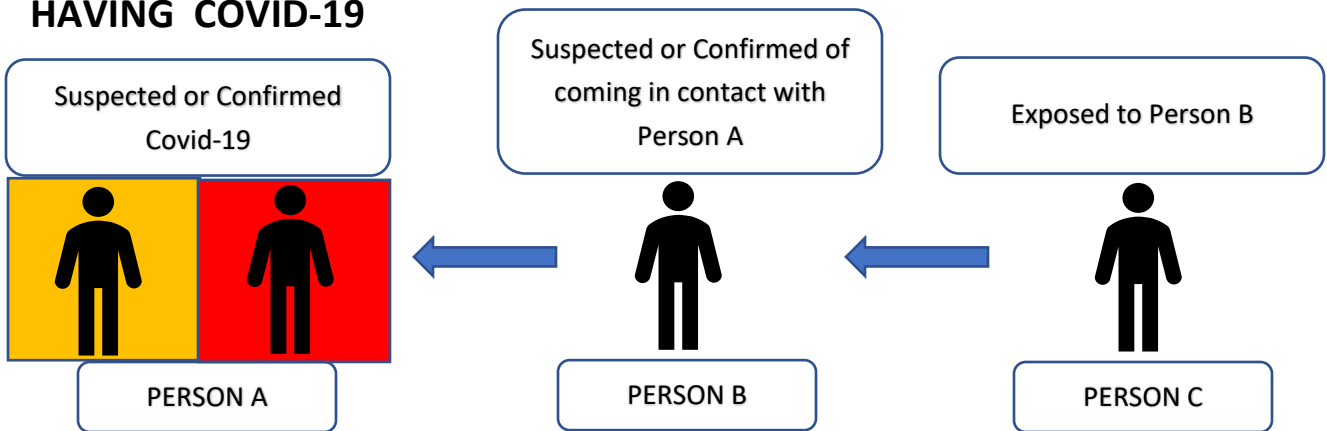
Both Person A and B will be isolated immediately, the parents will be contacted and health officials contacted for further instruction, risk assessments and recommendations.

SITUATION 4 – IF A STUDENT OR STAFF MEMBER HAS BEEN EXPOSED TO SOMEONE SUSPECTED OF HAVING COME INTO CONTACT WITH SOMEONE WHO THEMSELVES IS SUSPECTED OR CONFIRMED OF HAVING COVID-19



No restrictions apply to Person C



Person C may go to work and school



Immediately inform the Principal and Lead Team that they can monitor the situation



Situation 3 applies to Person B
