CISCO Global Skills Academy



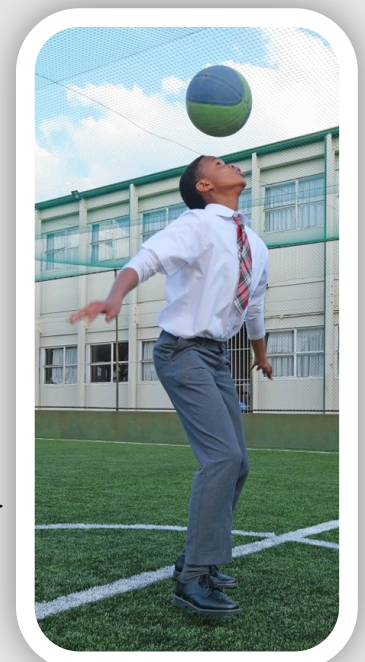
